Provide fire apparatus access roads to within 150 feet of the exterior walls of all new structures, measured along approved routes (as fire apparatus would travel, as fire hose would lay). Measured routes shall not cut through fences unless emergency access gates are provided.

Indicate locations of fire hydrants to meet fire code requirements.

As part of your construction plan submittal, include the calculations for needed fire flow for this project and indicate the approved method of calculation in use. Refer to Section 507 of the 2018 NC Fire Code for further information. Approved calculation methods include the following options:

- Appendix B of the 2018 NC Fire Code; or
- the ISO Fire Suppression Rating Schedule (as described in https://www.isomitigation.com/siteassets/downloads/guidedeterminerequiredfireflow.pdf).

Emergency responder radio coverage shall meet the requirements of Section 510 of the 2018 NC Fire Code for this project. Consider how these requirements, including any systems necessary to bring radio coverage into compliance with this section, may impact your plans.

A separate permit is required from the Winston-Salem Fire Department is required for the installation of aboveground or underground storage tanks used for the storage of flammable or combustible liquids. Removal of existing tanks shall also be coordinated with Winston-Salem Fire Department inspectors.

Note that buildings containing hazardous materials may be deemed Group H occupancies if the quantities of those materials exceed the maximum allowable quantities listed in the building and fire codes. Consider how the requirements placed upon Group H occupancies may impact your project.
