Resolution Awarding Construction Contract for Long Creek Phase 1 Improvements Project (North Ward)

The City advertised bids for Long Creek Phase 1 Improvements, a 2018 G.O. Bond project. The Phase 1 improvements cover 3.5 acres and include a new custom market shelter (40'x80'), new pool bathhouse with expanded concrete pool deck, fencing, stairs, concrete walks, site furnishings, LED site/parking lighting, native shade trees and perennials, site utilities, storm water measures, a 91-space parking lot and 1" overlay of the existing access driveway.

Bids were received on June 18, 2020, with a summary of bids as follows:

The low bidder, Garanco, Inc., has agreed to subcontract goals other than those established for this project; therefore, pursuant to the City's M/WBE Policy, the Internal M/WBE Committee and the Citizen's M/WBE Advisory Committee (CAC) met to review and consider all documentation of the bidder's good faith efforts which follow the resolution. The CAC determined that the bidder did make necessary good faith efforts to achieve the established project goals.

The low bid is within the available funding. The 2018 G.O. bond allocated \$1,600,000 for the construction budget, excluding the 10% project contingency. It is recommended that a contract be awarded to Garanco, Inc. the low bidder meeting specifications, in the total amount of \$1,531,600. The designer's estimate was \$1,650,535.

M/WBE comment: This project was advertised on the City and State websites and with several electronic plan rooms. Notifications were sent to all local M/WBE and regional HUB businesses on a weekly basis. See Exhibit A for a complete list of businesses that were notified the bidding opportunity and Garanco, Inc. Workplace Demographics form.
