Summary of Information:

In February 2020, the Mayor and City Council approved the termination of the previously approved economic development agreement between the City of Winston-Salem and Inmar, Inc. The termination of this agreement, which was supported by Inmar, Inc., allowed for the repurposing of funds that were originally designated for annual incentive payments to Inmar, Inc. to be used to support the Venture Winston initiative. The Venture Winston initiative was an effort backed by a collaborative of individuals and organizations associated with the city's entrepreneurial ecosystem including Inmar, Venture Café, Winston Starts, Flywheel and Greater Winston-Salem Inc., among others. The initiative was modeled after the City of St. Louis, Missouri's Arch Grants program. Arch Grants is a nonprofit organization that attracts start-up businesses to St. Louis by providing \$50,000 in equity-free grants and pro bono support services to entrepreneurs who locate their early-stage business in St. Louis.

Upon the Mayor and City Council's approval of the termination of the agreement, city staff provided Inmar, Inc. with documentation for their review and execution which would formally terminate the agreement and release the City from any and all future claims pursuant to the agreement by Inmar, Inc. Subsequently, Inmar, Inc. has elected not to follow through with the

termination of their economic development agreement. Inmar, Inc. is seeking to reinstitute its original agreement and this resolution would restore the funding for the economic development agreement that had been previously transferred.
