Summary of Information: The North Carolina Department of Transportation and the City of Winston-Salem entered into an agreement dated June 27, 2016 related to the betterments and associated cost sharing for certain elements of the Business 40 project. Throughout the project, the parties have agreed to supplement the original agreement. Additional betterments, design of the Multi-Use path, and maintenance responsibilities were included in the project scope. The additional betterments are summarized in the table on the next page.

These additional items total \$215,777 and change the total cost to the city to \$6,649,347. Sufficient funding is available and allocated for these improvements through the 2018 Bond Referendum.

Additionally, this amendment to the agreement formalizes the maintenance responsibilities for certain elements related to the Business 40 improvements. Sidewalks, Multi-Use Path, lighting, Green Street Bridge, Strollway Bridge, and any aesthetic betterments shall be maintained by the City of Winston-Salem per the supplemental agreement.
