Summary of Information:

The Curbside Division of the Sanitation Department has the need to purchase two scow bed dump trucks, intended as scheduled replacements for vehicles with high mileage and excessive maintenance and repair costs. See Exhibit A for complete vehicle replacement information.

On October 29, 2020, bid invitations were issued for two scow bed dump trucks and on November 13, 2020, the following bids were received:

Triad Freightliner of Greensboro, Inc. submitted two separate bids with each bid proposing a different engine configuration. Both of these bids by Triad Freightliner met or exceeded the original specifications for the equipment.

It is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to Triad Freightliner of Greensboro, Inc. for the purchase of two Freightliner M2 trucks with Godwin dump bodies that meet specifications required by the City in the amount of \$80,452 each for a total cost of \$160,904.

The purchase will be financed through the North Carolina Municipal Leasing Corporation. Funding for the lease payments is available in the General Fund FY 2020-21 budget.
