## **Summary of Information:**

The attached ordinance amendment, recommended for your approval, provides for enforcement of the Mayor's emergency proclamations/declarations through a civil enforcement process including the imposition of a civil penalty and allows the city manager to designate the appropriate city staff to undertake such civil enforcement efforts. Thus far, the Winston-Salem Police Department ("WSPD") has been responsible, primarily, for the enforcement of the Mayor's proclamations/declarations. The attached ordinance amendment, if approved, will afford WSPD the opportunity to redirect resources to other matters of a criminal nature while other city staff, designated by the city manager, take on such enforcement efforts. Additionally, the ordinance amendment makes it clear that the Mayor, where appropriate, can incorporate various provisions of any executive order issued by the governor into his proclamation/declaration, and provide for enforcement of such within the city limits. Finally, the ordinance amendment cleans up a few statutory references that have changed over time.
