Summary of Information:

The proposed amendments to the Fiscal Year 2020-21 budget ordinances authorize adjustments for the following purposes.

Appropriation of Grants and Other Revenues Received

□ The Police Department has received additional federal forfeiture funds from the United States Department of Justice totaling \$2,050, from the United States Department of Treasury totaling \$145,010, additional state controlled substance tax receipts from the Office of the State Auditor totaling \$87,080, and \$70 in contributions. These funds would be used for informant/drug buys (\$4,110) and for the purchase of equipment (\$230,100).

Remarks:				

- The Winston-Salem Police Foundation has donated \$30,000 towards the creation of the Real Time Crime Center at the Vivian H. Burke Public Safety Center. The funds will be used to purchase camera surveillance technology and a smartboard for the RTCC conference room for use during large scale events or critical incidents to brief command staff and/or other city officials. The proposed amendment appropriates the \$30,000 donation.
- □ In August 2020, the City sold land to Forsyth County Schools to build a new school. Six of the lots sold were originally purchased with housing finance assistance funds. The proposed amendment appropriates the proceeds totaling \$66,203.09 which would be used for housing development.
