## **Summary of Information:**

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 funds are apportioned to urban areas with more than 200,000 in population and are used for operating and capital assistance. The Winston-Salem Urbanized Area received an appropriation of FTA Section 5307 funding in the amount of \$5,218,153 for FFY 2021. The City of Winston-Salem is the designated recipient of this funding for the Winston-Salem Urbanized Area.

The Winston-Salem Urban Area Transportation Advisory Committee approved the FFY 2021 apportionments to the three eligible sub-recipients and Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) agencies for funding. Winston-Salem Transit Authority receives \$4,443,605, JARC services will utilize a total of \$55,000 and the Piedmont Authority for Regional Transportation (PART) receives \$579,407. Davidson County Transportation receives \$186,957 in FFY 2021. Davidson County Transportation will serve as a sub-recipient to the City of Winston-Salem for these funds.
