Summary of Information:

Chapter 160D is a comprehensive recodification and modernization of city and county development regulations passed by the North Carolina General Assembly and signed into law on July 11, 2019. Due to the pandemic, the deadline for local adoption of changes was delayed to June 30, 2021 (from January 1, 2021). Though these changes are not optional, most of our UDO complies with the new provisions. The 122-page Chapter 160D translates to approximately 26 pages of text amendments in UDO-CC10.
