#### **Summary of Information:**

The proposed amendments to the Fiscal Year 2020-21 budget ordinances authorize adjustments for the following purposes.

#### **Appropriation of Grants and Other Revenues Received**

□ The Winston-Salem Transit Authority has received additional revenue for the FY 2019-20 Elderly & Disabled Transit Assistance Program (EDTAP) in the amount of \$39,760. The proposed amendment appropriates these funds to cover EDTAP eligible expenses.

## **Quarry Park Pollinator Garden**

- □ In February of 2020, the City received a grant of \$125,000 from the Winston-Salem Foundation for the creation of a pollinator garden at Quarry Park. The pollinator garden was added to the design and construction bid of the 2018 Bond Quarry Park
  - Phase II project. The proposed amendment transfers \$40,000 from the grant to cover initial construction of the pollinator garden as part of the Quarry Park – Phase II project.
