Project Description:

Project Health is a leading manufacturer and distributor of vitamins and nutritional supplements. The company currently has two facilities: the headquarters/manufacturing facility in New York and a manufacturing facility in Davidson County, NC. Project Health would consolidate these facilities into an existing building at Whitaker Park for the manufacture and distribution of vitamins and nutritional supplements.

The company's workforce at its existing Davidson County facility is 41.8% female, 21.8% African-American, 5.4% other minority, and 72.7% Caucasian. In New York, the workforce is 39.5% female, 3.8% African-American, 60.5% Hispanic/Latino, 24.3% other minority, and 11.4% Caucasian.

The project would create 160 new positions in its first year with plans to grow to over 260. The company anticipates making \$3 million of capital improvements to the existing building, as well as invest \$18.7 million in new machinery and equipment.

Winston-Salem is one of several locations being considered for the project, including New York, South Carolina, and Virginia. The company is seeking financial assistance to offset the capital outlay associated with the consolidation. Staff is prepared to recommend an incentive package of \$264,592 which represents 50% of the net new tax revenue the project is anticipated to generate over a 5-year period.
