**Summary of Information:**

Pursuant to Section 78-352 of the Winston-Salem City Code, all Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity expire one year after their issuance. The City Council may renew the certificate in the absence of any contrary evidence and upon the finding of the Public Safety Committee that the certificate holder has the ability to comply with the provisions of the City's Vehicle for Hire Ordinance.
