## Summary of Information:

The City of Winston-Salem has received a petition from Sara March Barber to close and abandon a portion of Sherwood Drive. The area petitioned for closure is an unopened 25-foot platted right-of-way extending west approximately 165 feet from Fenimore Street. It is bounded on north by Tax PIN 6824-48-3968 and on the south by Tax PIN 6824-48-4805.

The Public Works Department has reviewed the request. There are no Planning or Winston-Salem Department of Transportation concerns if this right-of-way is closed. Sanitation services will not be interrupted. There are public utilities located in this right-of-way, the City would need to retain easements.

Staff recommends approval of the petitioner's request to close and abandon a portion of Sherwood Drive.
