**RESOLUTION APPROVING NAMING OF QUARRY PARK IN HONOR OF  
TIMOTHY A. GRANT**

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Timothy A. Grant's journey began as District Recreation Supervisor in 2003, and he became the first African American Recreation Director; and

**WHEREAS**, in total, he served the citizens of Winston-Salem for 19 years; and

**WHEREAS**, he led the department through the most significant expansion in facilities in more than a generation and had many notable accomplishments throughout his tenure with the City; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1999, Mr. Grant received the City of Winston-Salem's Employee Excellence Award for Staff Support and was also awarded the City of Winston-Salem's Employee Excellence Award for Leadership in 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the 228-acre Quarry Park project was a vision of Mr. Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2015, his vision became a reality with the construction groundbreaking of Quarry Park; and

**WHEREAS**, as required by the City Council's adopted policy on naming of City-owned buildings and facilities, the advisory body overseeing the facility, the Recreation and Parks Commission, supports a resolution recommending the naming of Quarry Park in Honor of Mr. Timothy A. Grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that Quarry Park be named in honor of Timothy A. Grant.
