## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM THE NORTH CAROLINA GOVERNOR'S HIGHWAY SAFETY PROGRAM FOR A SECOND YEAR OF FUNDING FOR A BIKESAFE REGIONAL COORDINATOR POSITION

WHEREAS, the City of Winston-Salem was awarded a second year of grant funding in the amount of \$5,000 from the North Carolina Governor's Highway Safety Program (GHSP) for a member of the Winston-Salem Police Department to serve as Regional Coordinator for its BikeSafe Program; and

WHEREAS, the responsibilities of the BikeSafe Regional Coordinator are planning, preparation, and reporting activities for BikeSafe NC training and events; continued promoting and involving law enforcement agencies in these lifesaving endeavors; organizing events, respond to public inquires associated with their region, and report all efforts and activities back to the BikeSafe NC Statewide Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used to finance in-state and out out-of-state travel expenses incurred with these activities, including outreach to area coordinators, attendance at the North Carolina Governor's Highway Safety Program Traffic Safety Conference, and an annual training symposium in an out-of-state location to be determined; and

WHEREAS, there is no match for this grant that begins October 1, 2021 and ends September 30, 2022.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Mayor and City Council authorizes the acceptance of this grant from the North Carolina Governor's Highway Safety Program for a

second year of funding for a Regional BikeSafe Coordinator position, as outlined above, by the appropriate City officials, upon approval as to form and legality by the City Attorney's Office.
