**WHEREAS**, the Operations Division of the Fire Department has the need to replace worn out turnout gear that will reach its 10-year service life during 2021. The purchase will include 27 replacement sets, 30 primary and backup sets for a recruit class of 15, and 5 sets for unforeseen incidents, such as gear being condemned and or unrepairable throughout the year; and

WHEREAS, on 4/1/2020, The National Purchasing Partners Government Division (NPPGov), a cooperative purchasing group, awarded the competitive bid contract #PS20070 for turnout gear per bid specifications to Municipal Emergency Services, Inc. of Charlotte, NC; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Emergency Services, Inc., has offered quote # QT1433917 for 62 turnout gear sets at a cost of \$2,700.64 per set each for a total cost of \$167,439.68; and

**WHEREAS,** N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3) authorizes "purchases made through a competitive bidding group purchasing program, which is a formally organized program that offers competitively obtained purchasing products and services at discount prices to two or more public agencies"; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a purchase order be awarded to Municipal Emergency Services, Inc., per The National Purchasing Partners Government Division (NPPGov) contract #PS20070 and quote # QT1433917, for 62 turnout gear sets per bid specifications at a cost of \$2,700.64 per set each for a total cost of \$167,439.68.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, that a purchase order is hereby awarded to Municipal Emergency Services, Inc., per The National Purchasing Partners Government Division (NPPGov), contract #PS20070 and quote # QT1433917 for 62 turnout gear sets per bid specifications at a cost of \$2,700.64 per set each for a total cost of \$167,439.68. This recommendation is in accordance with N.C.G.S. 143-

129(e)(3), and that the bid specifications, the company's proposal, and

the City's purchase order will constitute the contract.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that award of these purchase orders constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidders. The City is not legally bound to perform the purchase orders until the purchase orders are duly executed by the City.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this purchase is included in the FY 2021-22 capital budget.
