Resolution approving a sole source purchase from Red Wave Technology of a handheld RAM Spectrometer for raw material identification by the Winston-Salem Fire Department

## Summary of Information:

The Fire Department is replacing its current Smith's Detection HazMat ID unit due to the manufacturer's ending support for this device. The RAM Spectrometer will be used to identify over 35,000 substances such as unknown solids and liquids, explosives, white powders, narcotics, and toxic industrial chemicals. The RAM will also be used to properly identify hazardous materials and weapons of mass destruction during major concerts, visits by high profile political figures, and during civil protest.

G.S. 143-129(e)(6) provides an exception for sole-source purchases that do not require formal bidding when "(i) performance or price competition for a product are not available; (ii) a needed product is available from only one source of supply." Red Wave Technology of Danbury, CT is the sole manufacturer of the ThreatID GLS spectrometer. There is no other available spectrometer for field use with these unique capabilities
