Resolution Awarding Purchase Order for Rollout Refuse Carts

Summary of Information:

The Refuse Division of the Sanitation Department maintains and stocks 96-gallon rollout refuse carts and replacement lids for the City of Winston-Salem. The carts, used by city residents as a container for curbside trash collections, are manufactured by Toter, LLC, with a rotationally molded feature that allows the carts to be stacked and housed within the Sanitation Department.

Toter, LLC, located in Statesville, NC, maintains a National IPA agreement through contract no. 171717 as awarded by the City of Tucson on February 1, 2018. The Sanitation Division has requested a quotation for 2,535 rollout refuse carts and 250 replacement lids per the contract specifications and Toter LLC has offered quotation #WG-10201391 for the 2,535 carts at the cost of \$53.80 each, 250 lids at the cost of \$15.10 each, and total shipping cost of \$9,601.20 for the total cost of \$149,759.20. It is recommended that a purchase order for 2,535 rollout refuse carts and 250 lids per the contract specifications, be awarded to Toter, LLC per quotation #WG-10201391 for the total cost of \$149,759.20.

This recommendation is in accordance with N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3) which authorizes "purchases made through a competitive bidding group purchasing program, which is a formally organized program that offers competitively obtained purchasing products and services at discount prices to two or more public agencies."
