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RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE ORDER FOR FOUR DOOR SEDANS

WHEREAS, the Criminal Investigations Division of the Winston-Salem Police Department and Fleet Services Department have the immediate need for 12 four door sedans, 11 of which meet or exceed Fleet Services criteria for replacement and one of which will be an addition to the fleet; and

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2021, the North Carolina Department of Administration awarded contracts for passenger vehicles and Modern Imports of Winston-Salem, Inc. was awarded competitive bid contract #202100002 per bid specifications.; and

WHEREAS, Modern Toyota has offered a quotation for twelve 2022 Toyota Camry LE Sedans at a cost of \$22,632.10 each for a total cost of \$271,585.20; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3) authorizes "purchases made through a competitive bidding group purchasing program, which is a formally organized program that offers competitively obtained purchasing products and services at discount prices to two or more public agencies"; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a purchase order be awarded to Modern Imports of Winston-Salem, Inc., per N.C. Department of Administration contract #202100002, for the purchase of twelve 2022 Toyota Camry LE Sedans at a cost of \$22,632.10 each for a total cost of \$271,585.20.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, that a purchase order is hereby awarded to Modern Imports of Winston-Salem, Inc., per N.C. Department of Administration contract #202100002, for the purchase of twelve 2022 Toyota Camry LE Sedans at a cost of \$22,632.10 each for a total cost of \$271,585.20. This
