Summary of Information:

The City of Winston-Salem has received a petition from David Carpenter to close and abandon a portion of a 10-foot alley off N. Cameron Avenue. The area petitioned for closure is an unopened 10-foot platted right-of-way that extends west from N. Cameron Avenue and is approximately 110 feet in length. It is bounded on north by Tax PIN 6835-87-3862, on the south by Tax PIN's 6835-87-3793, 6835-87-3743, and part of 6835-87-2755.

The Public Works Department has reviewed the request. There are no Planning or Winston-Salem Department of Transportation concerns if this portion of the alley is closed. There are no public utilities located in this right-of-way, with which the City would need to retain easements. Sanitation services will not be interrupted.

Staff recommends approval of the petition to close and abandon a portion of a 10-foot alley off N. Cameron Avenue.
