Summary of Information:

The Winston-Salem Police Department (WSPD) has the need to purchase 75 police pursuit vehicles, intended as scheduled replacements for vehicles with high mileage and excessive maintenance and repair costs. See Exhibit A for complete vehicle replacement information.

After due advertisement, bids for the purchase of 75 Ford Interceptor Utility police pursuit vehicles per bid specifications, were received on September 3, 2021, as follows:
