City Hall Roof

After reviewing the scope of work, confirming the relative availability of M/WBE firms, and discussing contract specification, the City's Internal M/WBE Committee identified subcontracting opportunities in the areas of masonry. M/WBE participation goals were set at 7% and 4%.

The contractor solicited quotes from certified firms for any work for which the company is qualified, including the specific trades listed below. The contractor received quotes from certified M/WBE firms for those in *italics*.

- Electrical (WBE Quote Received; Used in Bid;)
- Portable Toilets (WBE Quote Received; Used in Bid;)
- Material Suppliers (WBE Quote Received; Used in Bid;)
- Masonry

With its bid, the contractor reached participation of **0%** with certified minority-owned businesses and **0.001%** with certified women-owned businesses. Because the established goal for minority participation was not achieved, the contractor was required to provide the City with Affidavit D, which documents their efforts to reach the set M/WBE participation goals.

In the review conducted by the M/WBE Citizens Advisory Committee, the contractor must accumulate a minimum of 115 out of 180 points to demonstrate a Good Faith Effort. For comparison, the State of North Carolina requires 50 out of 100 points. The contractor accumulated an average score of **155.4**, thus demonstrating a Good Faith Effort for M/WBE participation.

Owen's Roofing Inc. will be required to subcontract a minimum of **0%** of this contract with certified minority-owned businesses and **0.001%** with certified women-owned businesses.
