- ✓ Health Screening Questions for Employees and Guests
- ✓ Hand Sanitizers Throughout Fairgrounds, Including Midway
- ✓ Masking
 - <u>Required</u> Indoors (Annex, Education Building, Home and Garden Building, Livestock Buildings, Restrooms, etc.)
 - Strongly Encouraged Outdoors
 - Employees and Vendors Strongly Encouraged at All Times
- ✓ Sanitizing Supplies and 50,000 Masks Already On-Site
- ✓ Signs Deployed Throughout the Fairgrounds
 - Health and Hygiene Reminders
 - Masking
 - Social Distancing

Maintaining Healthy Environments


- ✓ Multiple Cleaning and Sanitation Teams
 - High Touch Areas, ATM's, Bleachers, Benches, Trash Cans, Concessionaire Counters, Restrooms, Entry and Exit Touch Points
- √ Frequent and Daily Sanitation of Rides
- ✓ Hand Sanitizers at All Game Stations
- ✓ Ride Guests to be Separated by Families and As Requested
- ✓ All Entertainment Will Be Outdoors.
- ✓ Restrooms Assigned Individual Attendants
- ✓ One-Directional Foot Traffic Where Applicable
- ✓ Open Air Facilities Will Have All Doors Open.

Maintaining Healthy Operations

- ✓ Follow Guidelines from CDC, NCDHHS, County, and Mayor's Emergency Declaration
- ✓ Daily Health Screening Questions
- ✓ Crowd Control
 - Staff Positioned at Entrances (Grounds and Indoor Buildings), Potential High Congregation Areas, Roaming (Carnival Midway, Outdoor Food and Beverage Areas, Annex)
- ✓ Promote Use of Advance Tickets
 - Encourage purchases via website and mobile app
- √ Touchless Ticket Scanning
- ✓ Metal Detectors No Touch Bag Checks
- ✓ Concessionaires Will Follow All State and Local Guidelines
- ✓ Signage, Frequent Public Address Announcements, Social Media Communications

Maintaining Healthy Operations Continued

- ✓ Pricing Strategy to Spread Attendance
 - Friday Opening Night Special: \$5 All Day/Night Admission
 - Ride Wristbands: Prices Increased for Wednesday, Saturdays, and Sundays
 - Kids 12 and Under: Free
 - Seniors 65 and Older: Free
 - Early Bird Tickets to Encourage Non-Peak Entry (Monday Thursday;
 11 a.m. 4 p.m.): \$5
