Resolution Awarding Construction Contract for Robbins Road Culvert Replacement (East Ward)

**Summary of Information:**

The City advertised bids for the Robbins Road culvert replacement project. The scope of work involves demolition of existing and install a new 72” diameter drainage pipe and road resurfacing.

Bids were received on September 20, 2021, with a summary of bids as follows:

The low bidder, RES Carolinas, LLC, agreed to the M/WBE subcontracting goals established for this project of 5% with minority-owned businesses and 5% with woman-owned businesses.

It is recommended that the contract be awarded to RES Carolinas, LLC, the low bidder meeting specifications, in the estimated amount of \$200,375.38. On February 15, 2021, the City Council approved \$230,000 for this project.

M/WBE comment: This project was advertised on the City and State websites and with several electronic plan rooms. Notifications were sent to all local M/WBE and regional HUB businesses on a weekly basis. See Exhibit A for a complete list of businesses that were notified the bidding opportunity and the low bidder’s Workplace Demographics form.
