Summary of Information:

The City of Winston-Salem is the owner of Tax PIN 6809-81-7797 which is a 38.12-acre parcel of the Long Creek Park. Sophia A. Porter is the owner of a house located at 1710 Bethania-Rural Hall Road. The City has been approached by real estate agents representing Ms. Porter, bringing to the City's attention that a portion of a detached garage encroaches on the City-owned parcel of the Long Creek Park. Ms. Porter would like to sell the property and is requesting an encroachment agreement with the City for this garage area. The encroachment agreement would run with the land and transfer to any future owners of the property at 1710 Bethania-Rural Hall Road.
