## **Summary of Information:**

Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Utilities (WSFC Utilities) currently owns and maintains a portion of the sanitary sewer system located on Wake Forest University's (WFU) main campus that WFU would like to acquire. WFU has requested to enter into an agreement with the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Utility Commission to convey this sanitary sewer system to Wake Forest University.

Upon execution of the agreement, WSFC Utilities will have no further responsibility for the inspection, operation, maintenance, repair and replacement of this sanitary sewer system. WFU will take on said responsibility.

WFU will grant WSFC Utilities the right to enter WFU's campus to inspect, operate, maintain, repair and replace the conveyed sewer line in the event a sanitary sewer overflow along the public sewer located upstream of the conveyed sewer line is precipitated by a blockage or break not addressed by WFU in a timely manner. The limits of the conveyed sewer lines are further described in the attached map. The WSFC Utility Commission has approved this conveyance.

The attached resolution authorizes the execution of an agreement conveying the associated public sewer main infrastructure to WFU as described herein.
