RESOLUTION REVISING EROSION CONTROL FEES SUBSEQUENT TO THE ADOPTION OF HOUSE BILL 489

WHEREAS, erosion control staff are responsible for the oversight and administration of grading and land disturbing activities for all areas within Forsyth County (except Kernersville, King, and High Point); and

WHEREAS, the City and County have adopted fees for the administration of said services; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly adopted House Bill 489 on August 30, 2021 which establishes fee requirements for local governments related to erosion control activities; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to revise its fee schedule for erosion control activities in order to comply with the provisions of HB 489; and

WHEREAS, staff has worked collaboratively with representatives from the Home Builders
Association in developing a revised erosion control fee schedule; and

WHEREAS, the proposed fee structure may result in a slight reduction in collected revenues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, upon recommendation of the City Manager, that the revised erosion control fees be adopted as shown on Attachment 1 titled "Revised Erosion Control Fees," with an effective date of November 15, 2021.
