Authorize the Expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$750,000 for the rehabilitation of 1200 Willie Davis Drive and 1635 N. Cleveland Avenue, based upon the bidding process and subsequent contract approval by City Council; 2. Authorize the execution of 1 year leases with the current residents of 1200 Willie Davis Drive and 1635 N. Cleveland Avenue at their prior rental rate (\$420.00-\$475.00 per month depending upon their prior lease) commencing June 1, 2023 and ending May 31, 2024, with the option to evaluate the leases before

the lease expiration date for possible increases of an incremental nature; and 3. Authorize the execution of a contract extension with the current management company (Majestic Premier Property Management, LLC) to coincide with aforementioned lease period based upon the current management fee (8% of the gross rental income).
